and the consequential order passed by the 2nd respondent in his proceedings F.No.SRO/NCTE/APS08321/B.Ed/TN/2014-15/58686 dated 16.07.2014 and quash the same as illegal and arbitrary and in violation of Principles of natural justice and in violation of section 17 of the National Council for Teacher Education in respect of withdrawal of recognition of the petitioner college and consequently directing the 1st respondent to cause Inspection of the premises of the petitioner college as per the decision of the 1st respondent in its 239th meeting within a time frame fixed by this Court.
