2.In view of the above submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Writ Petition stands dismissed as withdrawn. No costs.

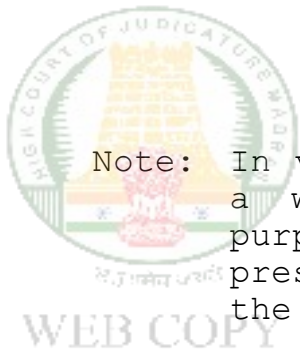
