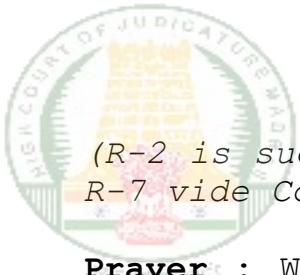

There shall be no order as to costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.

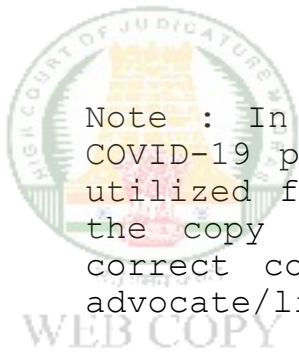
