In view of the submission made, permission is granted. The writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

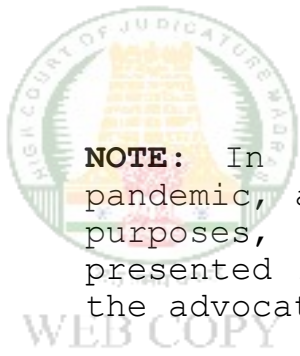
