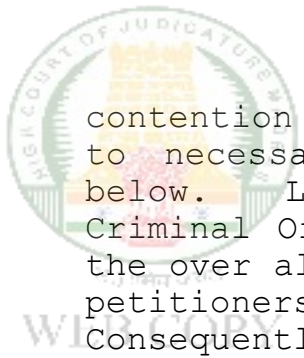
O R D E R

3.The petitioners' counsel drew my attention to the order dated 23.10.2018, passed by a learned Single Judge of this Court allowing the quash petition filed by one of the accused. Though the said
