4. This Criminal Original Petition stands allowed.

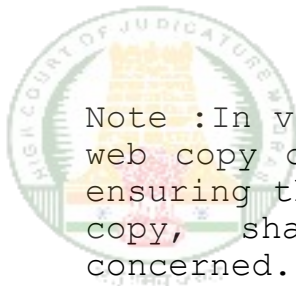
