3. Therefore, leaving open the remedies of the petitioner, this writ petition is disposed of.

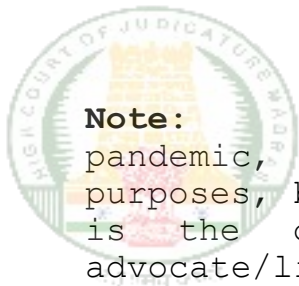
