2.Leave granted. This Criminal Original Petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

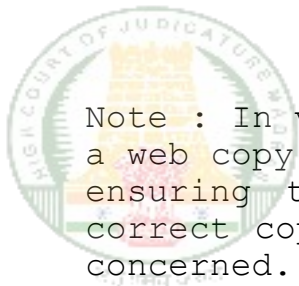
