4. Since in such cases, Courts take a stand that the final report has not been filed, the second respondent is directed to make verification in this regard. If the final report is not available, a fresh copy of the final report shall be filed and the jurisdictional Magistrate shall take a call in the matter on merits



and in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
