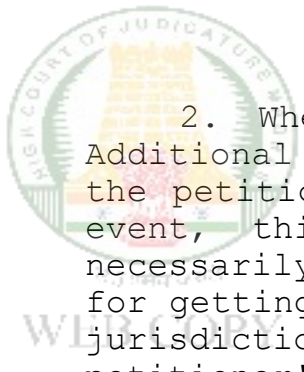

Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed. No costs.
