liberty to the petitioner to approach before the concerned Court.

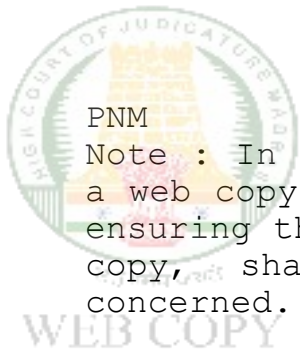
