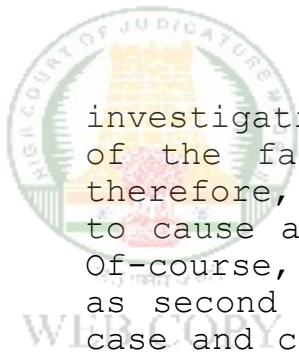
O R D E R

2.As rightly pointed out by the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) that the FIR itself was registered only on 19.01.2022. Therefore, the petitioner cannot rush to this Court.

3.Be that as it may, the fourth respondent is directed to bear in mind the grievances expressed by the petitioner and conduct the

The fourth respondent should take note of the fact that the petitioner is the defacto complainant and therefore, the investigation should be done in such a manner as not to cause any doubt or apprehension in the mind of the complainant. Since I have before me case and counter case, the fourth respondent shall follow the usual procedures in such matters.
