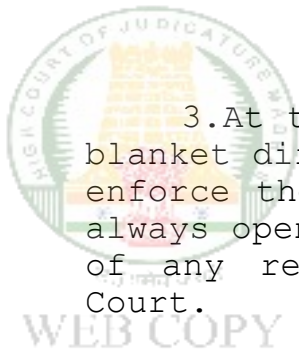

ORDER

This Writ Petition is filed seeking for police protection in the light of the judgment passed by this Court in S.A.(MD)No.1215 of 1999 dated 27.08.2019 by considering the representation of the petitioner.

2.A perusal of the affidavit filed in support of this Writ Petition would indicate that despite the decree in favour of the petitioner, some disturbance is there to exercise his right of administering the shops and other buildings. Therefore, the petitioner seeks police protection.



3.At the outset, this Court is of the considered view that such blanket directions cannot be granted and it is for the petitioner to enforce the decree as per law in the execution proceedings. It is always open to the petitioner to seek police protection in the event of any resistance by the judgment debtors before the Executing Court.

4.With the above observation, this Writ Petition stands dismissed. No costs.
