Considering the above, the third respondent is directed to issue notice to the petitioner and the seventh respondent, conduct enquiry and after giving an opportunity of hearing to both of them, pass orders on merits and in accordance with law within a period of six(6) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

4. With the above direction, this Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.

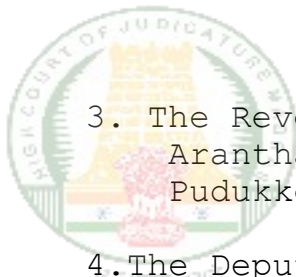
