3.Recording the said submission, this criminal original petition is disposed of.

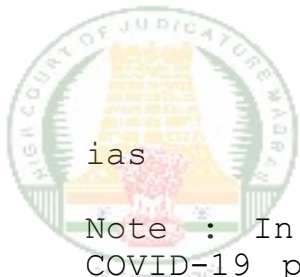
