3. Recording the said undertaking, this Writ Petition is allowed. No costs.

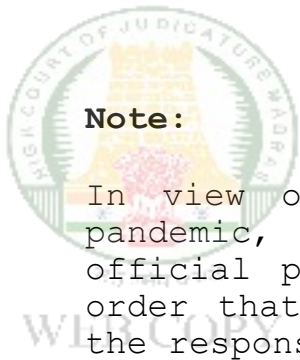
