no.11 of 2021, on the file of the second respondent police.

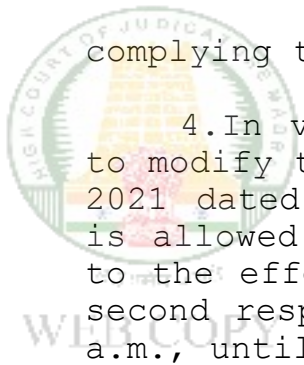
ORDER:- This Petition coming on for orders on this date and upon
