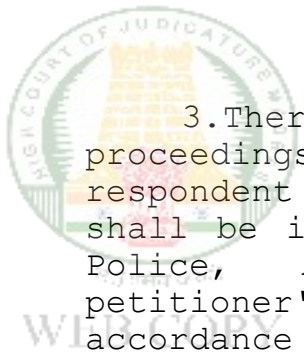

3. Therefore, the first respondent is directed to issue proceedings transferring the case from the file of the second respondent to Anti Land Grabbing Special Cell. The Inspector of Police, Anti Land Grabbing Special Cell shall investigate the petitioner's complaint and file the final report on merits and in accordance with law within a period of five months after the files are received.

4. The Criminal Original Petition is allowed accordingly.
