3.Recording the said submission, the Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.

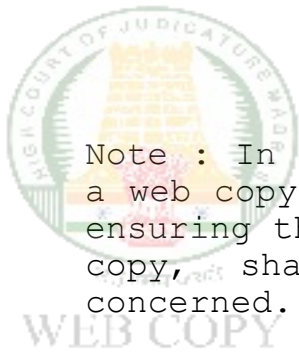
