Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of a WRIT OF MANDAMUS directing the respondents to pay the petitioner's interest at the rate of 18 percentage per annum, for the period of delay from 01.07.19 to 24.01.21, in paying the amounts paid towards the terminal and pension benefits of the petitioner namely EPF Employees Contribution, Gratuity and Commuted Value of Pension, within a time frame as may be fixed by this Court.
