Prayer: Contempt Petition filed under Section 11 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, to punish the Contemnor / Respondent for willfully disobeying and not complying with the order of this Hon'ble Court dated 29-07-2021 in WP(MD).No.13060 of 2021.

Prayer in WP(MD) . 13060/ 2021 :

Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondent to pay the petitioner interest at the rate of 18 percentage per annum, for the period of delay from 01.05.20 to 01.06.21, in paying the amounts paid towards his terminal benefits namely EPF Employees Contribution, Gratuity and Encashment of Earned/Sick Leaves within a time frame as may be fixed by this Hon'ble Court and without affecting his right to claim balance amounts towards those benefits and thus render justice.

The learned counsel for the respondent and the learned counsel for the petitioner made a submission that the order passed in the writ petition has been complied with. However, 6% interest, as applicable to the commutation alone is yet to be paid.



2. Thus, the respondent has to look into the issue regarding payment of interest for commutation, in accordance with rules and settle the same accordingly. The Contempt petition stands closed.
