Prayer in CRL OP(MD) . NO.16586/2021:-

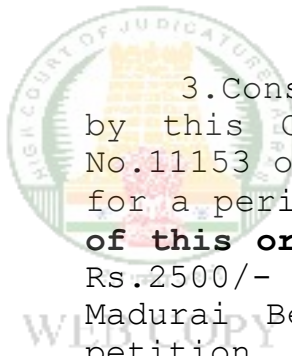

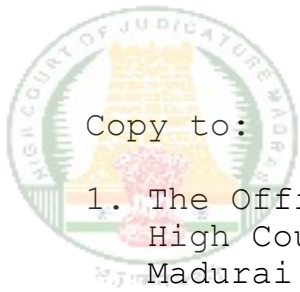
