PRAYER IN CRL A(MD) No.443 of 2019:

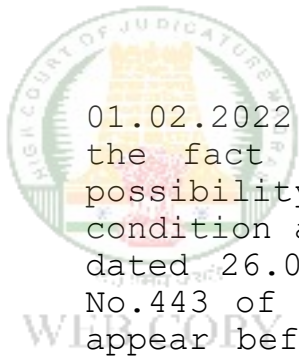
