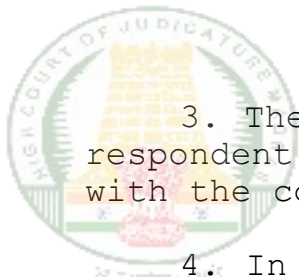
PRAYER IN CRL A(MD)NO. 390 OF 2021:

Order : This petition coming up for orders on this day, upon perusing the petition filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of MR.K.KATHIRESAN, Advocate for the petitioner and of M/S.M.AASHA, Government Advocate (Criminal Side) on behalf of the Respondents the court made the following order:-
