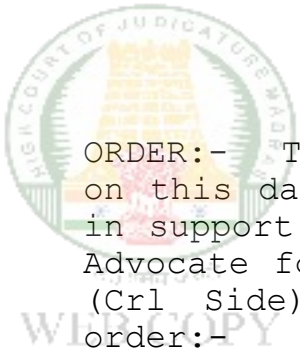

Prayer in Crl.MP(MD)No.4474 of 2022 :- Criminal Miscellaneous Petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C., to extent the time for the order passed by the Hon'ble Court in Crl.R.C.(MD)No.666 of 2021 dt.22.09.2021 and pass such further or other orders as this Hon'ble Court.
