2.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondents would submit that the representation of the petitioner dated 08.02.2022 seeking leave for one week was rejected today.

3. Mr.R.Alagumani, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that he could be given atleast a days leave to attend 20th day Ceremony of his mother, who died on 06.02.2022.

4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondents would submit that if the petitioner files a fresh application seeking a days leave, the same will be considered favourably.

5. Hence, this writ petition is disposed of permitting the petitioner to file a fresh application seeking leave for a day which the respondent will consider sympathetically. No costs.
