PRAYER: Contempt Petition is filed under Section 11 of the Contempt of Courts Act praying to punish the respondents for the willful disobedience of the order, dated 26.07.2021, passed by this Court in W.P. (MD) No.12514 of 2021.

Prayer in WP(MD) . 12514 of 2021 :

Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue appropriate Writs, Orders or Directions and in particular issue a WRIT OF MANDAMUS directing the respondents to pay the petitioner interest at the rate of 18 percentage per annum, for the period of delay from 01.04.20 to 01.06.21, in paying the amounts paid towards the terminal and pension benefits of the petitioner namely EPF Employee's Contribution, Gratuity, Encashment of Earned/Sick Leaves and Commuted Value of Pension, within a time frame as may be fixed by this Honble Court and without affecting his right to claim balance amounts towards those benefits and thus render justice.
