Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a WRIT OF MANDAMUS direct the respondents to disburse petitioners retirement benefit of the difference arrears amount of Gratuity for Rs.27,631/- and leave salary for Rs.41,695/- in variable Dearness Allowance and in Total Amount is as Rs.69,326/- together with interest at the rate of 6 percentage per annum payable as per court direction in one Instalment to the petitioner within a stipulated time frame as fixed by this Honble Court from the date of retirement to till the date of actual payment and pass such further or other orders as this Honble Court may deem fit and proper in the circumstances of the case and thus render justice.
