ORDER

The writ petition is filed for issuance of a writ of mandamus seeking a direction to the official respondents to provide compensation to the petitioner for the offence committed by the 8th respondent herein under Sections 376, 506(i) @ 366 A, 376, 307 r/w 34 IPC registered in Crime No. 56/2008 on the file of the 7th respondent.

2. It is reported that subsequent to the filing of writ petition, the petitioner died on 29.07.2020. Subsequently, Mrs.Santhosam, the petitioner's mother and her minor daughter have been impleaded as petitioners 2 and 3.
