Common Prayer: Contempt Petitions filed under Section 11 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, to punish the contemnors/respondents herein for their wilful disobedience of the order passed by this Court dated 18.09.2020 in W.P.(MD) No.12042 of 2020, W.P.(MD) No.13046/2021 dated 29.07.2021 and W.P.(MD) No.17759/2021 dated 30.09.2021.

Prayer in WP(MD). 12042 of 2020 :

Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court To issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to pay the Service Surrender Leave Salary amount of Rs.16,767/- payable to the petitioner for the period from 2009 to 2016, together with 18 percentage interest from

the date of his retirement i.e.31.05.2017 to till the date of payment and all other attendant benefits to him within the stipulated period.

Prayer in WP(MD). 13046 of 2021 :

Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a Writ of Mandamus, to direct the respondent to pay the petitioner interest at the rate of 18% per annum for the period of delay from 01.05.2020 to 01.06.2021, in paying the amounts paid towards his terminal benefits namely EPF Employee's Contribution, Gratuity and Encashment of Earned/Sick within a time frame as may be fixed by this Court and without affecting his right to claim balance amounts towards those benefits.

Prayer in WP(MD). 17759 of 2021 :

Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondent to pay the petitioner interest at the rate of 6% per annum, for the period of delay from 01.05.2019 to 26.01.2021, in paying the amounts paid towards petitioner's terminal benefits namely EPF Employee's Contribution, Gratuity and Encashment of Earned/Sick Leaves, within a time frame as may be fixed by this Court and without affecting petitioner's right to claim balance amounts towards those benefits.
