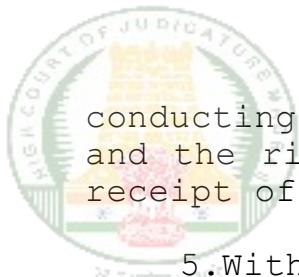
ORDER

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conducting enquiry and also issuance of summons to the petitioner and the rival party within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
