PRAYER IN CRL MP(MD)No. 2673 of 2022 IN CRL OP(MD)NO.1254 of 2022:

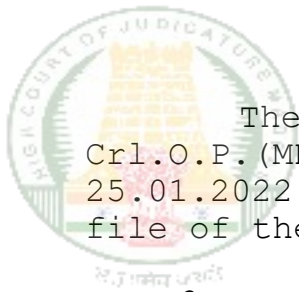
