When the matter was taken up for hearing, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner states that the matter has become infructuous.

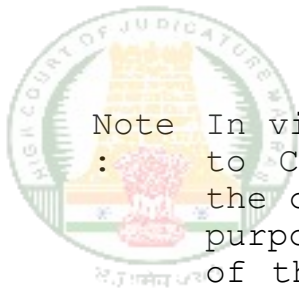
2.Recording the same, this writ petition is dismissed as infructuous. No costs.
