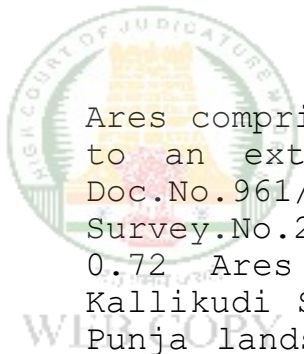
Prayer : Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the 2nd respondent to issue Non-traceable Certificate with regard to the Original Sale Deed registered in (I) Doc.No.959/1997, admeasuring 0.88 Ares comprised in S.No.233/4C, (ii) Doc.No.960/1997, admeasuring 0.4 Ares comprised in Survey.No.233/4E, (iii) Doc.No.960/1997, admeasuring 0.18 Ares comprised in Survey.No.233/4D, (iv) Doc.No.961/1997, admeasuring 0.5 Ares comprised in Survey.No.233/4A and (v) Doc.No.960/1997, admeasuring 0.72 Ares comprised in Survey.No.233/4B on the file of the Kallikudi Sub-Registrar Office, Madurai District with regard to the Punja lands situated at Kenjampatti Bit-2 Village, Peraiyur Taluk, Madurai District based on the petitioner's representation dated 18.02.2021, through registered post within the time limit that may be stipulate by this Court.
