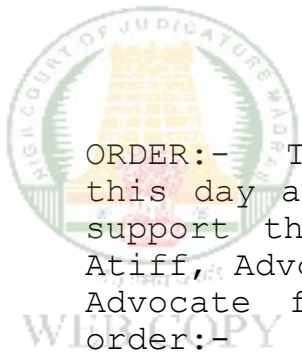

Prayer in WMP(MD)No.3448 of 2022 :- Writ Miscellaneous Petition filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India, to extend the time granted by this Hon'ble Court vide its order dated 29.10.2021 made in W.P.(MD)No.1429 of 2013 for making payment of the remaining due Rs.305.07 Lakhs for a further period of 3 months from 13.03.2022 pending disposal of the above writ miscellaneous petition and thus render justice.

Prayer in WP(MD)No.1429 of 2013 :- Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court To issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, to call for the records pursuant to the impugned order passed by the second respondent in Ref.No.F&R/833/2012 dated 02.01.2013 and quash the same and consequently directing the 2nd respondent to charge 8% of interest as per SIPCOT O.O.7/2005 dated 24.05.2005 and also to consider the representation dated 10.04.2012.
