PRAYER: Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents 2 and 3 to conduct the survey and demarcate the petitioner's property in S.F.No.100/23 with an extent of 10.50 Ares and S.F.No.100/26B, with an extent of 20 Ares of Punja Lands situated in Vilathupatti Revenue Village, Illuppur Taluk, Pudukottai District, on the basis of the petitioner's representation, dated 24.01.2022 and 25.02.2022.

ORDER

This writ petition has been filed for a Mandamus seeking for a direction to the respondents 2 and 3 to conduct the survey and demarcate the boundaries to the petitioner's property situated in S.F.No.100/23 with an extent of 10.50 Ares and S.F.No.100/26B, with an extent of 20 Ares of Punja Lands situated in Vilathupatti Revenue Village, Illuppur Taluk, Pudukottai District, on the basis of the petitioner's representation, dated 24.01.2022 and 25.02.2022.

2.It is the case of the petitioner that she is the absolute owner of the aforementioned properties. She has submitted representations on 24.01.2022 and 25.02.2022 to the respondents,



requesting them to conduct survey and demarcate the boundaries. Since the representations have not been considered till date, she has filed this writ petition.

3.Heard Mr.R.Paranjothi, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr.D.Sasikumar, learned Additional Government Pleader, who accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

4.No prejudice will be caused to the respondents, if the petitioner's application seeking for survey and demarcation of boundaries for the aforementioned properties are carried out, after giving notice to the petitioner as well as the other rival claimants, if any.

5.Accordingly, this Court directs the second respondent to conduct the survey and demarcate the boundaries in respect of the petitioner's properties comprised in S.F.No.100/23 with an extent of 10.50 Ares and S.F.No.100/26B, with an extent of 20 Ares of Punja Lands situated in Vilathupatti Revenue Village, Illuppur Taluk, Pudukottai District, with the assistance of the third respondent, within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, after giving notice to the petitioner and other rival claimants, if any.

6.With the aforesaid directions, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
