2.In view of the above submission, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed as infructuous.

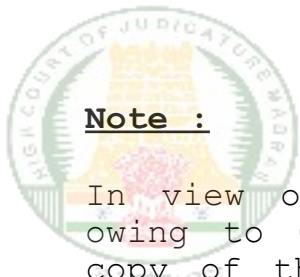
