Prayer : Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus, to direct the respondents 1 and 3 to consider the petitioner's representation, dated 17.02.2022 and to remove the encroachment caused by the encroachers in Survey Nos.2, 3, 4, 5, 11, 12, 14, 16, 20, 156, 159, 177, 185, 190, 192, 203, 213, 214 in Patta No.1 situated at Adankarkulam, (Shanmugapuram, Soundara Lingapuram, Ooralvaimozhi), Survey Nos.1761 to 1769, 1982 to 1986 in Patta No.828 situated at Pazhavur-II, (Madhaganeri, Sembikulam), Survey Nos.659, 660, 667, 668, 672, 674, 678 in Patta No.3 situated at South Valliyoor, (Melakadambankulam) and Survey Nos,625, 2264 in Patta No.1297 situated at North Valliyoor (Valliyoor) by virtue of the order in C.R.P.(NPD).(MD).No.1697 of 2014 dated 16.12.2021 within stipulated time fixed by this Court.
