PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents 1 and 2 to survey and measure petitioner's property comprised in survey number 473/11 measuring an extent of 000.12 cents situated at Anna Street, Vilachery, Madurai District and consequently third and fourth respondents herein to provide adequate police protection to property on the basis of the petitioner's representation dated 06.03.2022 within the time stipulated by this Court.

O R D E R

This writ petition has been filed for a Mandamus seeking for a direction to the first and second respondents to survey and measure petitioner's property comprised in survey number 473/11 measuring an extent of 000.12 cents situated at Anna Street, Vilachery, Madurai District and consequently third and fourth respondents herein to provide adequate police protection to property on the basis of the



petitioner's representation dated 06.03.2022 within the time stipulated by this Court.

2.The petitioner has submitted a representation to the respondents on 06.03.2022 seeking for survey and demarcation of boundaries in respect of the aforementioned property which she claims that it belongs to her absolutely. Since the said representation has not been considered till date, this writ petition has been filed.

3.Heard Mr.J.Vishnu, learned Counsel for the writ petitioner and Mrs.S.Jeyapriya, learned Government Advocate who accepts notice on behalf of respondents 1 to 4.

4.The petitioner has produced documents in support of her case that she is the owner of the aforementioned property. She has sought for a survey and fixation of boundaries by the appointment of a Surveyor and the petitioner has given a representation on 06.03.2022 for the said purpose.

5.No prejudice would be caused to the respondents if the representation of the petitioner dated 06.03.2022 is considered on merits and in accordance with law after hearing the petitioner as well as the rival claimants if any.

6.Accordingly, this Court directs the second respondent to survey and fix the boundaries in the petitioner's property in S.No. 473/11 measuring an extent of 000.12 cents situated at Anna Street, Vilachery, Madurai District after giving notice to the petitioner and rival claimants if any within a period of twelve [12] weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. If required, the second respondent shall seek assistance of the fourth respondent police for the purpose of conducting survey and demarcation of the petitioner's land.

7.With the above direction, this Writ Petition stands disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.

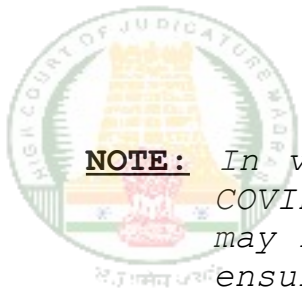
