3.In view of the above, these Criminal Revision Cases are dismissed as infructuous. No costs.

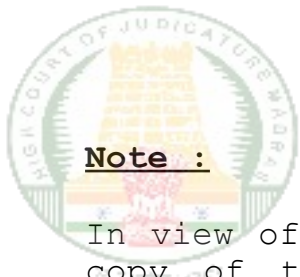
