Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court S-12. to issue Writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate writ or orders or direction in the nature of writ, directing the respondents to pay 6 percent interest for the belated payment of terminal benefits of P.F., Gratuity and Unavailed Leave Salary and Commutation, payable to the Petitioner from the date of his retirement i.e. 30.04.2019 to till the date of actual payment made to him i.e. 25.01.2021 and all other attendant benefits to him within the stipulated period and to pass such other



or further orders as this Honble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case and thus render justice.
