PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

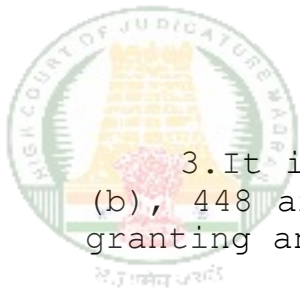
PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.Not known of 2022 on the file of the respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/Accused, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 294 (b), 323 and 506(ii) IPC, in Cr.No.Not known of 2022, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.When the matter is taken up for hearing today, the learned Government Advocate (Crl. side) would submit that the FIR came to be registered in Crime No.38 of 2022 for the offences under Sections 294(b), 448 and 323 IPC.



3. It is seen from the FIR, the said offences under Sections 294 (b), 448 and 323 IPC, are bailable offence. Hence, the question of granting anticipatory bail does not arise.

4. In view of the above, the Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
