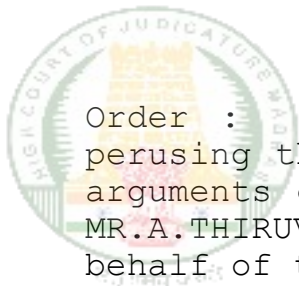

PRAYER IN CRL A(MD)No.229 OF 2022:

To call for records and setaside the judgment and conviction dated 26/10/2021 passed in C.C.No.66 of 2017 by the Learned Additional District & Sessions Judge(Spl.Court for EC/NDPS Act Cases) Pudukkottai under section 14A(b) of Foreigners (Amendment) Act 2004 to undergo Rigorous Imprisonment for 4 years and to pay fine of Rs.10,000/- each in default to undergo simple imprisonment for the period of 3 months and for offence punishable under section 294(b) of IPC to undergo Rigorous Imprisonment for 2 months and for offence punishable under section 353 of IPC to undergo Rigorous Imprisonment for 1 year and for offence punishable under section 506 (ii) of IPC to undergo Rigorous Imprisonment for 3 years and acquit the appellants from all charges.
