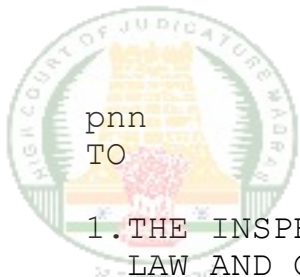
2.In view of the submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner and the endorsement made by him, this Criminal Miscellaneous petition is dismissed as not pressed.
