2.The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the respondents 1 and 2 would submit that the second respondent already completed the investigation in Crime No.77 of 2022 and filed referred charge-sheet before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Mudhukulathur on 03.04.2022 and the same has been closed as 'undeducted' on 05.04.2022.

3.In view of the above, no investigation is pending on the file of the second respondent. Therefore, the Criminal Original Petition is dismissed. However, the petitioner is at liberty to file a



protest petition in the manner known to law, if she is so advised.
