3.In view of the above, the Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.

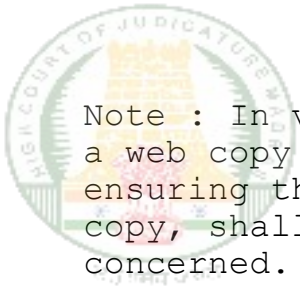
