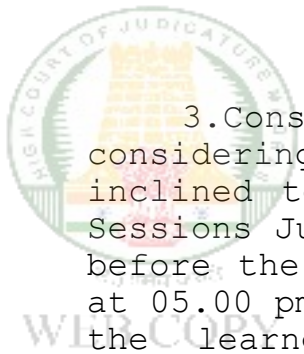

4.With the above direction, the Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
