2.The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioners are the daily wagers and they are not in a position to deposit a sum of Rs.5,000/- each as directed by this Court.



3.The learned Government Advocate (Crl. side) would submit that this Court, considering the damages caused, has rightly imposed the said condition.

4.Considering the above, I do not find any reason to reduce the amount fixed by this Court, in its order dated 04.03.2022. Hence, this petition is dismissed.
