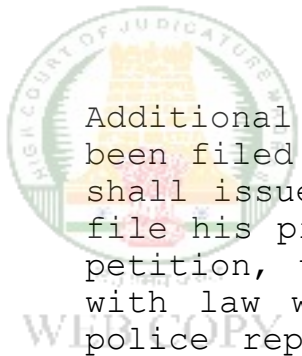

The Court below shall issue RCS notice to the petitioner so that the petitioner can file his protest petition. If the petitioner files such a protest petition, the same will be disposed of on merits and in accordance with law within a period of four weeks thereafter. Even if the police report is accepted by the Court below, the petitioner is always having the liberty of filing a private complaint against the accused. This is not a case in which transfer of investigation is going to yield any result.

3.With this liberty to the petitioner and with the aforesaid observation, this criminal original petition is disposed of.
