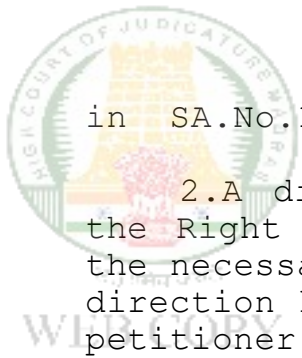

3.No prejudice will be caused to the respondents, if a direction is issued to the fourth respondent to comply with the directions of the first respondent, dated 14.12.2021, passed in SA.No.14909/E/2021, within a time frame to be fixed by this Court.

4.Accordingly, this Court directs the fourth respondent to comply with the directions issued by the first respondent on 14.12.2021, in SA.No.14909/E/2021, within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5.With the aforesaid directions, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs.

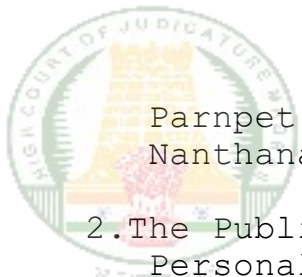
